White Pass & Yukon Railroad

Denali National Park

The ultimate wilderness and home to stunning Mount McKinley. Denali offers a good chance to spot one of Alaska's legendary 'Big Five' – moose, caribou, grizzly bear, Dall sheep and wolf – in a spectacular setting. Tall mountains, ice-blue glaciers, flowered meadows, and so much more.

August 11	Dawson City, Yukon Territory
August 12	Eagle and Tok (via <i>mv Yukon Queen II</i> river cruise and coach). Cruise the legendary 'River of Gold' and tour historic Eagle
August 13	Fairbanks. View the TransAlaska pipeline and visit Gold Dredge No. 8 to pan for gold
August 14	Denali National Park (via McKinley Explorer Rail)
August 15	Denali National Park. Tundra Wilderness Tour
August 16	Anchorage (via McKinley Explorer Rail)
August 17	Anchorage. Transfer to airport for your return flight to Toronto
