Experience sun-kissed Lesbos before ending in Istanbul, meeting place of the continents. Savour three nights of Turkish delight, visiting the Blue Mosque and Topkapi Palace, shopping the Grand Bazaar and touring the Bosphorus by boat before heading home.
