Dividing Pacific from plains, the soaring, snow-capped, chiselled peaks of the Rocky Mountains are rich in natural beauty, wildlife, lore and Canadian legend. Begin in Calgary, with its stetsons and skyscrapers. Journey the Trans-Canada Highway to the foothills and discover Banff National Park. Follow the Icefields Parkway and rove the Athabasca Glacier by all-terrain Ice Explorer. Stroll the Glacier Skywalk above valleys and waterfalls before boarding the legendary Rocky Mountaineer in Jasper. Venture deep into the Rockies, following the rails west and south across the Continental Divide. Traverse plunging valleys and high passes to Kamloops and on through endless forest and lush landscapes to Vancouver. Discover Lotusland at leisure before returning home.
