Activity Level | **Active**

Day 1	Depart from Toronto or Winnipeg to Lima
Day 2	Lima – Upon arrival, transfer to hotel. Afternoon Lima city tour with San Francisco Monastery and Gold Museum B/D
Day 3	Lima – Depart to Cusco by flight. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel, balance of your day at leisure B/D
Day 4	Cusco – City tour and evening dinner with folkloric show at a local restaurant B/D
Day 5	Cusco – Transfer to Sacred Valley and visit Pisac's famous market B/L/D
Day 6	Sacred Valley – This morning, embark the Vistadome train to Aguas Calientes. Upon arrival, transfer to Machu Picchu by shuttle bus B/L/D
Day 7	Aguas Calientes – In the morning, visit Machu Picchu. Afternoon departure to Ollantaytambo by train, where you will be transferred to Cusco by coach B/D
Day 8	Cusco – Depart to Puno by the Titicaca train. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel B/L/D
Day 9	Puno – Full-day sightseeing of Uros Islands and Island of Taquile B/L
Day 10	Puno – Depart to Juliana for your flight to Lima. On your way, you will visit the Chullpas of Sillustani. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel B/D
Day 11	Lima – Transfer to Pisco, for your Nazca Lines tour. In the afternoon, transfer to Inca for an overnight stay B
