Explore China from Terracotta Warriors to Tiananmen Square, Great Wall to Guilin. Visit Shanghai with its neon skyline, contemporary art, ancient treasures and legendary acrobats. Discover ancient Zhujiajiao, the Venice of the Orient, and Longshen and Guilin's spectacular terraces and limestone mountains. Take in bamboo groves, wooden pagodas, rice paddies, lumbering water buffalo and fishing cormorants before cruising the Yangtze's Three Gorges beneath towering cliffs. Explore Xi'an's unearthed wonders, trek the Great Wall and discover Beijing's imperial history and modern grandeur. Enjoy a noodle-making demonstration, a pedicab ride through time, traditional music, an Imperial dinner and bustling markets along the way.
